There's plenty of time for gameplay and relaxation during the tournament.

The journey that began with the campus tournament has led to Orlando. Now it is time to take the next step in the "Evolution of a Champion." Let the HCASC NCT begin!

To experience HCASC to its fullest, make the most of your time both on and off the buzzer. Here are some friendly tips.

1. Take advantage of the opportunities to meet and get to know players from other teams, both in your division and in the tournament as a whole. You will meet up with these people over and over in life; it pays to network now!

2. Eat sensibly; avoid sugar and too much "junk food." Eat a healthy, light breakfast before morning games.

3. Get exercise every day to keep your mind and body energized. When you can, take a walk or go for a swim.

4. Enjoy the Expo, but don't stay up too late! Get enough rest to recharge your brain cells every night. The more REM sleep you get, the sharper your mind will be for gameplay. **5.** Be on time! It reduces stress and helps the tournament run more smoothly. Not just for games either; punctuality helps keep banquets and other NCT events running smoothly.

7. Learn from the teams you compete against or watch, but don't change the way you approach each game. Every team's strategy is unique.

9. Watch games in other divisions to pick up info and to see competitors outside of "your room." You may meet them in the playoffs.
